TOP OF GERMANY: ASCENDING THE ZUGSPITZE, 2963 m VIA “REINTAL”-ROUTE

Explore Germany's highest mountain over three days via the famous “Reintal”-route. Starting in Garmisch Partenkirchen this route leads through one of the loveliest alpine valleys of the eastern alps. After spending the night on the “Reintalanger”-Mountain Hut, 1366 m, the summit is achieved after a day of hiking in an impressive alpine environment. The view from the summit on a clear day offers a panorama of Munich and a huge part of the Bavarian and Austrian Alps. After a rejuvenating overnight in the “Knorrhütte”-Hut the descent is via Ehrwald in Austria and then transfer back to Garmisch.

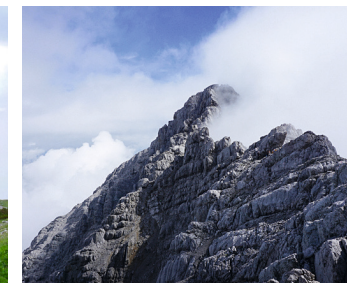

CROSSING THE WATZMANN: KING OF THE BERCHTESGADEN ALPS NATIONAL PARK

Two memorable days – crossing the “Watzmann”-Crest on Germany's second highest mountain. The first day is ascending to the “Watzmannhaus”-Mountain hut. The second day starts the adventurous traverse with thrilling views down the famous “Watzmann”-East-face, and to the picturesque “Königsee”-Lake. After achieving all three peaks of the “Watzmann”, the demanding descent challenges the successful mountaineers down the west-face of the “Watzmann”. The tour is an invigorating 2000 m of altitude difference in total. Return route through the fabulous Wimbachgries-Valley.
